- ⤴ Did you know that until 100 years ago this year wherries used to carry freight on the Aylsham Navigation which ran from the current head of navigation at Coltishall to Aylsham via locks at Horstead / Coltishall, Buxton, Oxnead, Burgh & Aylsham?
- ⤴ Did you also know that the whole thing ended as a result of a devastating flood which washed away all the locks and most of the bridges including the one between Coltishall & Horstead?

In 2012 we are commemorating the 100th anniversary of the flood and the closure of the Navigation. We have also formed a new charity to protect and preserve the history, flora and fauna of the River Bure along the Navigation – we are called the Bure Navigation Conservation Trust (BNCT) and our membership application is overleaf.

We are planning events around the commemoration, particularly **on August 26th 2012** which is the anniversary to the day of the flood and Navigation's closure.
